The Center of Excellence on Autism Spectrum Disorders at Southern Connecticut State University is excited to sponsor a research program called *Artism*. The program consists of 10 weekly art making sessions that meet on Friday afternoons. A variety of art media and techniques will be introduced and applied, including colored pencils, watercolor, scratch art, and printmaking. The research aims to determine if participation in the *Artism* lessons increases social competencies in participants and if there are differences between inclusive and non-inclusive settings. Classes are taught by certified teacher Meg Hoffecker. There is a materials fee of \$25 for the eleven weeks and scholarships are available.
