

Learner Outcomes for the Sixth Year Educational Coach Program

At the end of this interdisciplinary Sixth Year Program between Elementary Education and Special Education the learner will:

1. Demonstrate skills in collaboration and consultation with teachers, administrators, and related service providers to all children, regular education and special education.
2. Demonstrate the skills and abilities to provide in-service training, workshops and modeling related to children with special needs, diversification of instruction and collaboration
3. Demonstrate skills for assessing all students' needs and diversifying instruction in the general curriculum to meet the needs of inclusive settings.
4. Develop and demonstrate the skills for data-driven decision making, instructional coaching and enhancement of student engagement.
5. Demonstrate an understanding of the legal rights and responsibilities of teachers, students and parents.
6. Demonstrate the appropriate skills for classroom management for both group and individual situations.
