

Tailgating Regulations

Southern Connecticut State University

Lot 9 will open four (4) hours prior to the scheduled start of the game. Tailgating activities prior to the event must end at the start time of the designated contest. Parking in Lot 9 is limited, thus one car, one space will be enforced.

All tailgating areas will be cleared 30 minutes prior to the start of an athletic contest.

All tailgating areas must remain cleared while the game is in progress.

All tailgating areas will close one (1) hour after conclusion of game.

Note: Portable rest rooms are available in Lot 9. Additional facilities are located in Jess Dow Stadium.

*The university reserves the right to close down any tailgating area and to dismiss any person from the premises for violations of this policy or when it determines is required for public safety purposes.

In the event of an emergency: Police, Fire, Medical – Call 9-1-1

General Tailgating Regulations

Legal Restrictions:

- Attendees are expected to obey all laws and may face arrest and prosecution if the law is violated.
- The legal age for possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages in Connecticut is 21.
- It is illegal to provide alcohol to anyone under the age of 21.

Policy Restrictions: Violators will be asked to cease the behavior or leave the event. Those that persist may be subject to arrest and/or campus discipline.

- Anyone in possession of or consuming alcoholic beverages must produce a valid ID to Police or University Staff when requested.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages on any other part of the campus or on public streets that run through or adjacent to campus is prohibited.
- Kegs and glass bottles or containers are prohibited.
- The sale of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited.
- Drinking games (included but not limited to beer pong), and the use of devices intended to accelerate the consumption of alcohol (including but not limited to funnels or beer bongs) are prohibited.
- Loud, abusive language and behavior that prevent others from enjoying tailgating is prohibited. No large speakers or amplified music will be permitted.
- No solicitation of any kind is allowed. This includes banners, raffles, or the selling of any products (food, drink, apparel, souvenirs) without written permission from SCSU.
- Food and beverage may not be brought into Jess Dow Stadium.
- Charcoal grills are strictly prohibited. Use of propane grills are permitted with safety as the highest priority.
